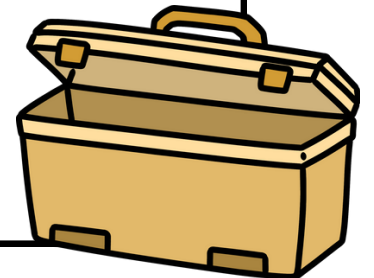

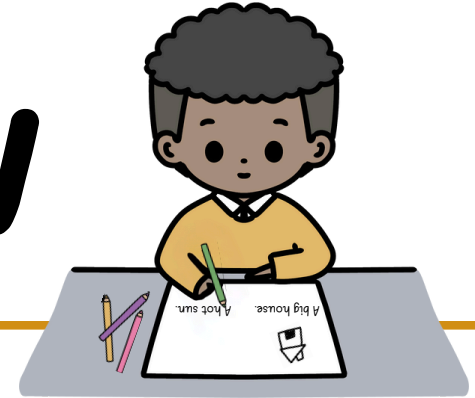

How to Play

- 1 In this activity the children will read the sentences and draw matching pictures.
- 2 Before they begin reading, spend some time exploring the sentences.
- 3 Start by identifying the new Phase 5 tricky words: **people, Mr, Mrs, looked** and **their** - familiarise the children with these words.
- 4 Next, find and highlight the different 'long a' graphemes within the words.
- 5 Once they feel confident, they can read the sentences and demonstrate understanding of what they have read by drawing a matching picture.
