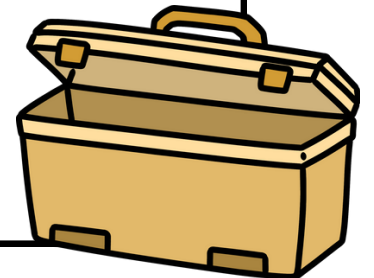

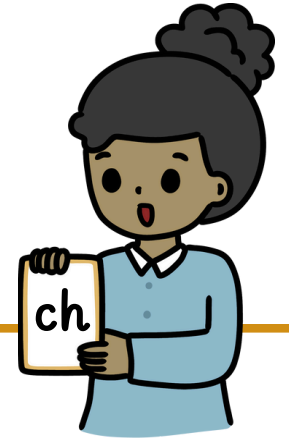

Beat the Clock



How to Play

- 1 Set a timer (suggested maximum time: 3 minutes).
- 2 Run through all of the Phase 3 digraphs using the flashcards, with the children aiming to beat the clock.
- 3 If the children beat the clock, they collectively win the point. If they don't, the adult steals the point.

Tip: Children must pronounce the sound correctly in order to move on to the next one.

Playing with One Child

If playing with one child, play in the same way, with the child aiming to beat the clock.



