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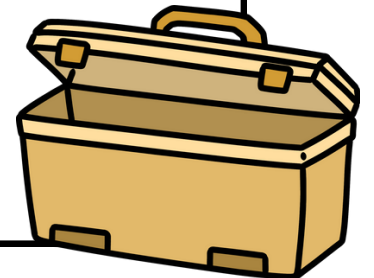
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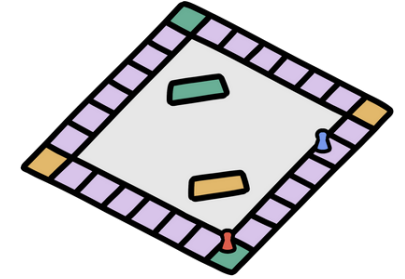
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Board Game



How to Play

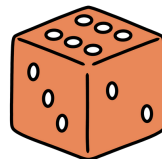
- 1 This game is best played in small groups, or one-on-one if playing with just one child and an adult.
- 2 To play, print the board game and give each player a record sheet and something to write with.
- 3 The board game has different **root words** (typically verbs) on the landing squares. Every time a player lands on a square, they must change the root word to its opposite by adding the 'un' prefix and recording it on their record sheet.
- 4 Players continue around the board until all words have been claimed, with the winner being the player with the most words.
- 5 To help vary the number of words claimed per player, a word cannot be claimed twice; rolling a '3' means 'miss a turn', and rolling a '6' means 'take another turn'.

Playing with a Large Group

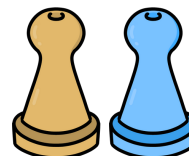
If playing with a large group, you can split the group into teams and enlarge the game on a screen. However, ensure each player has their own record sheet so that when their team lands on a picture square, all players can record the word individually.
